
WiMoVE: Reconfiguration of Wireless Networks


- How to operate large-scale Wi-Fi Networks?
 - Separate them into multiple L2 domains
 - Assign each user's devices to a virtual network
 - When user moves, extend the network to the new Access Point, remove it from the old one
- Savings created by reducing broadcast traffic outweigh the configuration overhead

System Architecture




- 1. Access Point: Network access for wireless clients
- 2. Gateway: Internet access to each network
- 3. Route Reflector: Distributes reachability information
